For the exploration of pedagogy requirement for this certificate, you may read your choice of five or six articles on teaching with technology. The articles should go into enough depth to give you new information, ideas, insights, viewpoints, etc., about educational technology, thereby enhancing your understanding of this topic. Any of the journals on the lists of general and discipline-specific journals will have occasional articles on teaching with technology. Here are a few others that focus on technology with brief descriptions from each journal's homepage. They are available online through the University of Illinois Library unless otherwise stated.

- *British Journal of Educational Technology* provides readers with the widest possible coverage of developments in international educational and training technology, and is a primary source for academics and professionals in learning technology.
- *Campus Technology* is one of higher education's top information sources. The monthly magazine delivers valuable information and is the go-to resource for campus professionals. It provides in-depth coverage on the technologies and implementations influencing colleges and universities across the nation.
- *Educause Review* takes a broad look at current developments and trends in information technology, how they may affect the college/university as an institution, and what these mean for higher education and society. EDUCAUSE is a nonprofit association whose mission is to advance higher education through the use of information technology and *Educause Review* is the association's open-access digital flagship publication for the higher education IT community. - *Journal of Research on Technology in Education* features peer-reviewed articles that report on original research, system or project descriptions and evaluations, syntheses of the literature, assessments of the state of the art, and theoretical or conceptual positions that relate to instructional uses of educational technology.
- *Journal of Teaching and Learning with Technology* is a fairly new international journal dedicated to exploring efforts to enhance student learning in higher education through the use of technology and is available at <u>http://jotlt.indiana.edu/</u>.
- **Research in Learning Technology** aims to raise the profile of research in learning technology, encouraging research that informs good practice and contributes to the development of policy.
