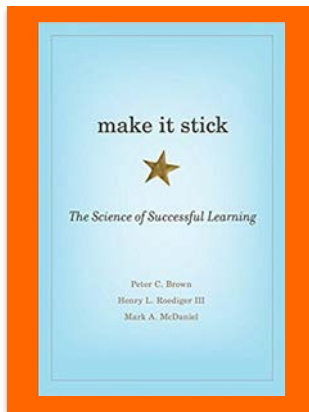




Fall 2017 Junior Faculty Seminar Series on Teaching & Learning
