PLACEMENT & PROFICIENCY TESTING

PLACEMENT TESTING

Placement exams determine what your knowledge and skills are in a subject so that we can then recommend an appropriate first course for you from the various options available at Illinois. Placement tests do not award academic credit (see "proficiency testing" below). All placement exams are made available to all incoming students. Take only the ones you need to take. If you never studied a particular subject, you don't need to take its placement test. To enroll in a subject that is completely new to you, you can simply register for its elementary-level course.

PROFICIENCY TESTING

The purpose of any proficiency exam is to find out whether you have mastered the knowledge and the skills that are taught in a particular

- Students who are level 5 are placed into either ESL 115 or RHET 105

Written Test Score	Placement Message
1	Must enroll in ESL 111 for Fall 2023; Supplemental tutoring is strongly recommended; Successful completion of the ESL 111-112 sequence fulfills the Composition I requirement.
2	Must enroll in ESL 111 for Fall 2023; Successful completion of the ESL 111-112 sequence fulfills the Composition I requirement.
3	Placed into ESL 115; Must enroll in Fall 2023 if UIN ends in an even number; Must enroll in Spring 2024 if UIN ends in an odd number; Successful completion fulfills the Composition I requirement.
4	Placed into either ESL 115 or RHET 105 (discuss with your advisor which course is appropriate for you); Must enroll in Fall 2023 if UIN ends in an even number; Must enroll in Spring 2024 if UIN ends in an odd number; ESL 111-112 or CMN 111-112 are other options. Successful completion of any of these fulfills the Composition 1 requirement.
<u>5</u>	Placed into either ESL 115 or RHET 105 (discuss with your advisor which course is appropriate for you); RHET 105 is likely the best fit. Must enroll in Fall 2023 if UIN ends in an even number; Must enroll in Spring 2024 if UIN ends in an odd number; ESL 111-112 or CMN 111-112 are other options but not recommended. Successful completion of any of these fulfills the Composition 1 requirement.


