

Graduate Academy for College Teaching

Schedule - August 2023

The Academy will be a hybrid format this August, with a combination of asynchronous online pre-work, live Zoom sessions, and live face-to-face sessions. Participants must complete the pre-work, attend all live sessions, and participate in Microteaching. Below is a tentative timeline for the event. All times Central. The full program will be ready before the Academy, and will be sent directly to registrants.

August 16, Wednesday

- Complete asynchronous pre-work before live sessions begin on August 17

August 17, Thursday

- 8:30am-9:45am - Welcome and keynote, face-to-face, Foellinger Auditorium
- 10:00am-11:00am - concurrent sessions A, face-to-face, classrooms on Main Quad
- 11:15am-12:15pm - concurrent sessions B, face-to-face, classrooms on Main Quad
- 1:30pm-2:45pm - small group sessions, online via Zoom
- 3:00pm-4:00pm - concurrent sessions C, online via Zoom
- 4:00pm-5:00pm - GEO session, online via Zoom

August 18, Friday, Microteaching Option #1

Participants attend one 90-minute Microteaching session, which will run throughout the day, face-to-face in the Armory building. Participants will later schedule an additional 30-minute playback meeting to get individual feedback. This is the best choice for those wanting to practice teaching before the semester begins, or those who prefer in-depth, individual feedback.

August 21-September 11, Microteaching Option #2

Participants attend one two-hour Microteaching session sometime in the early part of the semester, and will not schedule an additional 30-minute playback meeting as in Microteaching Option #1. This is the best choice for those who prefer to debrief in a group setting, or for those who can't attend a session on August 18.

Participants must choose one option or the other. Participants get to choose a Microteaching time as soon as they are registered. The sooner they are registered, the more choice of Microteaching time they will have.
